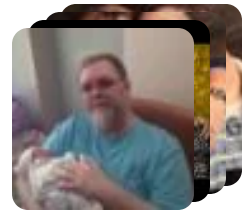
Julie Curtis-Horn posted:

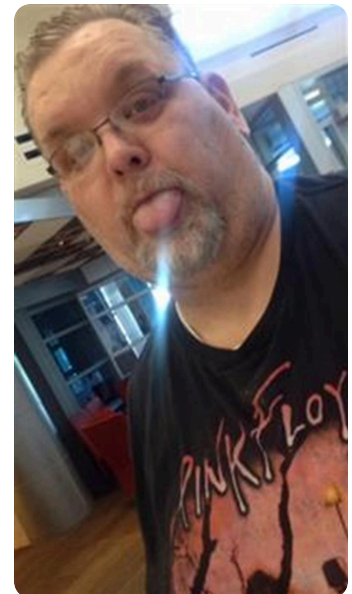
