Arrangements are under the direction of Wiscombe Memorial.



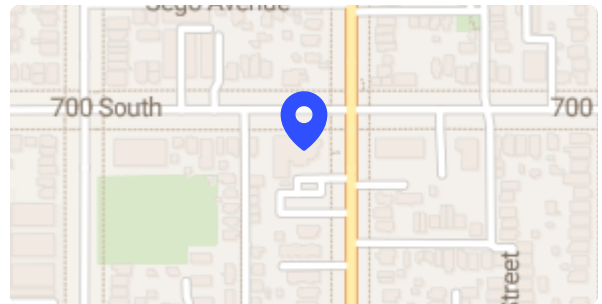

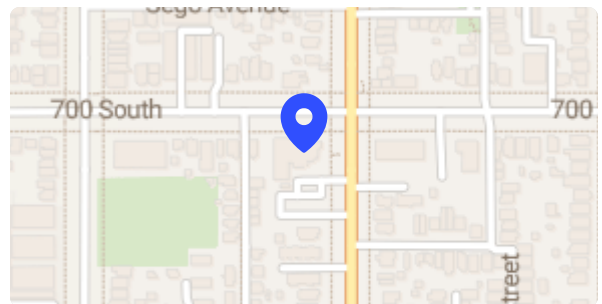

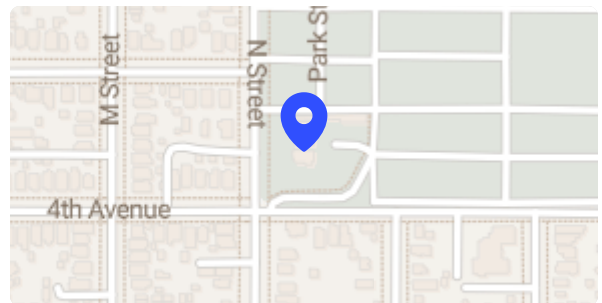
