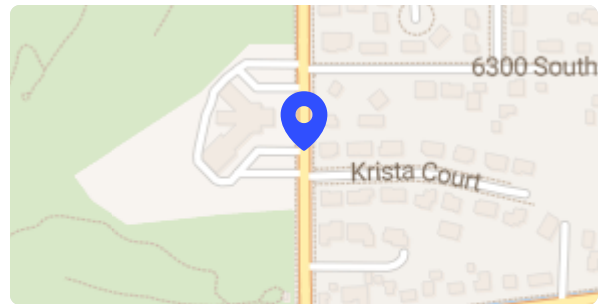

I guess Easter has been the hardest to deal with because you sooo loved that holiday and always made it special for all of us. I on the other hand failed it royally. Aiden went with his dad and I was at the extended stay by myself, except the cats and dog were here tried to give dog a haircut didn't go so well. Aiden finally got a tattoo in your honor it is a beta fish and he has been at me that him and I need to have a tattoo for you like we do for Eth. So, I am getting a beta fish and a pickle for Tori, don't ask:) I didn't think I would be your tat'd up daughter, but when you are fractured it is kindof like Russian roulette. I have talked with someone and it was brought up that I not only have some PTSD but also STSD (Secondary Traumatic Stress Disorder), it happens to nurses when they experience caregiver burn out. I use to think oh for pete sakes pull up your big girl panties but honestly it is sooo real and so overwhelming that until you experience it noone has any sort of idea. I am not making excuses but mom is takes you down some pretty scary rabbit holes that you think you will never get out of. I know you loved me beyond measure, but it is sad how some of the extended family have told me what a terrible daughter I am and I should have taken care of you and mom I swear that is what I wanted to do but I was in such a dark and scary place. Aunt Donnie won't acknowledge me or Wade and a lot of the extended family believe the lies and stories that were told about us by Lois and Ed. It hurts, but I am trying to get back and make you proud. I am excited to move to Texas, you would have loved it. Please give my son a hug and kiss and I hope you get to meet some of the patient's I had the privilege of taking care of that are amazing. Love and miss you!

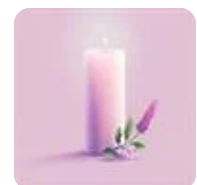
