# Antonio Maria Chacon

FEB 26, 1937 - FEB 8, 2024

**W**e are deeply heart broken that our father, grandfather and husband Antonio Maria Chacon died Thursday at 3am from natural causes. He is remembered for his love of fishing, hunting, watching tennis, boxing, all sports, watching Judge Judy, and always playing bingo. Dad cared deeply for animals, especially for his beloved cat "y la Cactus" who slept at his side every moment of the day. He was a proud Navy veteran who served in Korea. He loved reading the newspaper, drinking coffee, and "taking care of our mom" as he always joked. His favorite music was Englebert Humperdinck, a little bit of country, classical, and he brightened up when watching his grandson Orion play the guitar. He taught his daughters their ABCs with the guitar, and just loved the sound of it. He is remembered for singing "Volver" by Vicente Fernandez. Although he lived a long life of almost 87 (his birthday was on February 26), he will be deeply missed. At the end of his life his grandchildren took special care for him: Anthony, Vanessa, Ragina, Destiny, Felicia and Aundrea. We are blessed to have a united and loving family. Until we meet again "Take is easy".

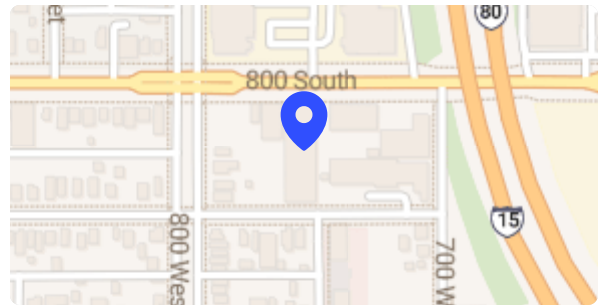

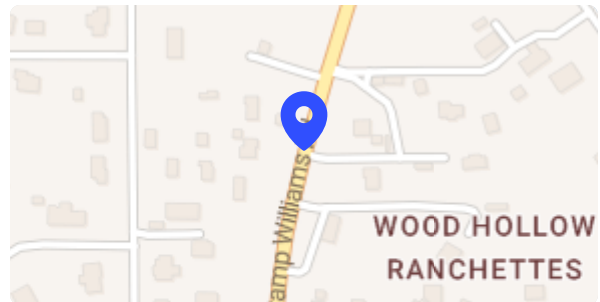

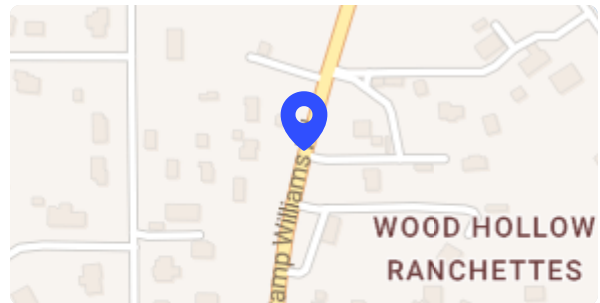
