She passed away on Friday, January 10, 2025, at Ogden Regional Medical Center in Ogden, Utah, from injuries sustained in an automobile accident. Mariah was preceded in death by her grandparents, Philip and Mavourneen Golle, and Louis and Patricia Menges; her brother, Caleb Menges; and her nephew, Noah Joseph Eklove-Menges. 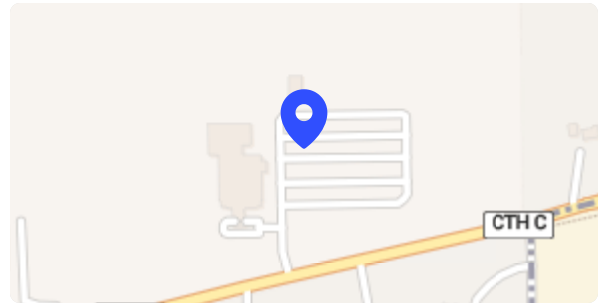

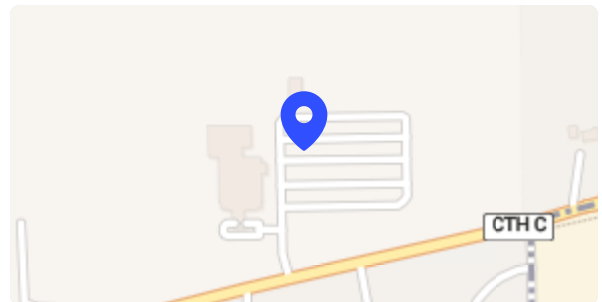
